Dear Mark:

This letter is being forwarded to you in an effort to provide aid directly to 400 displaced members of the WW II Veterans Home recently destroyed in New Orleans. The men have been transported by plane, bus and, when necessary, airlifted to a Veterans home in Washington, DC. The budget of the Washington, DC facility is incapable of supplying all of the needs of the Veterans so, through the Washington Post and local radio stations, donations have been solicited to purchase clothing, toiletries and the day-to-day items needed by these WW II heroes.

My law firm has already made a substantial donation to the Veterans Home and I am taking it upon myself to solicit additional cash contributions. Please note that we are trying to help all 400 of the displaced Veterans rather than buying 30 shirts here, 40 pairs of socks there. We would like each of the Veterans to be able to have the same items available to them since I am told they have absolutely nothing but the clothes on their back and some limited mementos, pictures, etc. Obviously, if the check is made payable to my law firm, it is not going to be a tax deductible contribution, but I am still asking for your assistance by making the checks payable to my law firm so that I can then go out to one of the bulk retail stores, purchase the items, deliver them personally and know that not one penny of the funds is being used for any administrative, personnel, postage expense, delivery expense, etc., that may be carved out of contributions made directly to the Red Cross. I'm not discouraging those contributions but rather am trying to creatively target these 400 men by getting them what they need as quickly as possible without having them wade through some giant bureaucracy to get them settled. Rest assured that every penny and then some will be used for these Veterans and no contribution is too small.



They also need playing cards, magazines, etc. I'm going to start with the basics and try to work my way down based upon how much money is received. Since time is of the essence, I would appreciate your opening your wallets and hearts as soon as possible so that these men who are already being resettled in Washington and undoubtedly are disoriented can begin a new life as soon as possible. They all gave of themselves for us and now its time to thank them again.
